NEW BUSINESS

Amy Welker discussed:

1. Summary Page of Chapter 50
 - a. The primary goal of all the changes made to the ordinance is to simplify and clarify the code so the citizens can have a clearer understanding of what their and the Cities responsibilities are. As we continue to enforce the new code, the processes will allow the City to become more efficient and provide the best possible service.

Questions asked:

Commissioner Grissom: Is there a concentration of customer complaints in one specific area?

Amy: No. If an area had to be chosen, then possible 1st Ward.

Commission Grissom: Is there a time limit/warranty on trash containers?

Amy: We have the ability to maintain, repair and replace containers.

Commissioner Grissom pointed out that now with the changes we can focus on how we can continue to improve and how to prevent abuse.

Amy requested that Chapter 50: Utility Board approve Code. Ron Pilkington moved for approval and Commissioner Chris Grissom seconded motion. Motion approved on September 07, 2022.

Kevin Krejny discussed:

1. Budget updates for Water, Wastewater, and Storm Departments- budgets have held steady.
2. Fees will remain the same for the next year with review for the 2024 calendar year.

Questions asked:

Ron Pilkington: Where do penalty fee funds go into?

Kevin: All penalty fee funds go to the appropriate fund; Ex: Stormwater fees to Stormwater accounts
