



**Golf Board Meeting
Work Session Minutes
Thursday, March 20, 2025**

The Piqua Golf Board met at 4 pm at Echo Hills Golf Course located at 2100 Echo Lake Drive, Piqua. Present were Assistant City Manager Amy Welker, Golf Manager Patrick Kirkland, Golf Superintendent Tim Missimer, Administrative Assistant Melissa Kinney, and the following board members: JD Denson, Mike Mohr, Brian Deal, and Ron Pearson Jr.

- The meeting was called to order by JD and seconded by Mike.
- A motion was made by Mike and seconded by Brian to approve the Meeting Minutes from the August 22, 2024, Golf Board Meeting. All were in favor and the motion was approved.
- Patrick said that 2024 was a great year for the golf course, and he expects similar results this season. Of course, warmer weather will help, but he said the past 3 weeks have been good. He reported that membership revenue is up \$3,400 so far in 2025. He announced that there is a League Meeting this evening. He said that they have created a separation between the red and blue tees and have received mostly positive comments about this change. He said they have also made changes to the handicaps on several holes as a true reflection of the course. New tri-fold scorecards are coming in July that will incorporate a new Pin Placement Card so that golfers will have variation in their play. A new "Today's Pin Placement" sign will be added at Hole #1.
- Tim reviewed his Winter Project List with the group. He talked about projects completed, such as tree work, driving range posts, completing his office space, organizing inventory and parts, pressure washing benches, and completing his Aquatics License for pond applications. Tim also shared some of his upcoming goals, such as greens aerification in April, setting up Approach stakes, planting trees, and maintenance of dead trees.
- Patrick commented that he is happy to have a full-time mechanic, who is proactive with cart maintenance and equipment maintenance. Patrick also said he will be offering the clubhouse menu on "Uber Eats" in April. JD suggested offering breakfast foods in the morning hours, such as breakfast sandwiches and bagels.
- A motion to adjourn the meeting was presented by JD and seconded by Mike at 4:52 pm.
